

VK 31 Base Board Connection Kit with Female Thread








a) Telescopic angle valve b) Connection Kit

Installing the Connection Kit





Important: This installation sequence must be followed!

■ When installing the VK 31 base board connection fitting, always mount and connect the lower connection bracket first according to the installation steps described.

Only start to install the upper connection bracket once the lower connection bracket has been installed.

- Once the radiator has been installed, measure and cut the connection pipe of the telescopic angle screw fitting to length and deburr.
 - Deburr the inside of the end of the pipe and chamfer the outside. Remove all swarf.
 - 1.2 Check pipes at the connection points for surface damage and impurities.
- 2 Push the telescopic angle screw fitting onto the connection pipe.
- 3 Screw the union nut onto the radiator and tighten with a size 30 open-ended wrench (use a connection nipple for radiators with 1/2" female thread or conical insert with 3/4" external thread Euro cone).

4 Remove the cover cap and screw the clamping ring screw union inte grated within the telescopic angle screw fitting in tightly at the front using a size 13 open-ended wrench.

Important:

Only use the valve spindle with a size 4 hexagon socket wrench to shut off the radiator <u>after</u> the installation work is complete. If this is completed in the wrong order, the spindle may be irreparably damaged and malfunction!

5 Screw the selected union adapter into the connection fitting. When screwing in, hold the hexagon head (size 27) of the connection fitting in place.

In the case of several radiators on one wall, first completely install the lower line connection.

Then install the upper line.


Shutting off the radiator

Remove the cover cap and shut off the telescopic angle screw fitting from the front using a size 4 socket wrench and rotating it to the right.

Important:

Only shut off the size 4 valve spindle once the integrated clamping ring screw union (size 13) has been fully tightened (clockwise).


